- **50 years ago there were 164**
- **Today there are 6,000**
- **This is an increase of 360%**

Higher Education Enrollments

- **From 1990 to 2000 enrollments in post-secondary education in Latin America DOUBLED.**
- **From 2000 to 2005 they doubled again.**
